The Core Project scholarship candidates must:

- demonstrate a commitment to intentionally using their influence to make a positive and lasting impact on their campus;
- graduate from an Idaho high school who participated in The Core Project during the 2019-20 academic year (**see attached list of eligible schools**);
- plan to enroll at an accredited college, university, or trade school in 2020.

APPLICATION

Electronic applications will be accepted until March 6, 2020. Incomplete applications will be disqualified.

2. **Complete and submit your electronic application.** Use a valid email address you check regularly. This will be our primary form of correspondence with you.
