- plan to enroll at an accredited college, university, or trade school in 2020.

### **APPLICATION**

Electronic applications will be accepted until March 6, 2020. Incomplete applications will be disqualified.

- 2. **Complete and submit your electronic application.** Use a valid email address you check regularly. This will be our primary form of correspondence with you.
